## Requirements:

- Segment 1: 24 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of driving lesson on the road, as well as 4 hours of observation.
- Some driving lessons are private. Student may be in the driver's training car for a short period of time with another student while he/she is being picked up or returned from the training session. Driving times will be scheduled at first day of class.
- A \$20 fee is charged if a student does not show up for a scheduled driving session, makeup class, or duplicated certificates.
- Books are sold to students for \$6 (optional).
- Student must receive a score of 70% or higher on final grade to pass. Up to two retakes in total allowed.
- Classes will be held at 1707 Plymouth Rd., unless a different location is posted. Absences permitted based on instructor scheduling and knowledge of absence.
- Proof of age (ex. birth certificate, passport, or legal id) available at the first day of class.
- The student must be at least 14-years and 8-months old by the first day of Segment 1. Verification by birth certificate is required.
- A minimum of 30 hours of supervised driving, including two hours of nighttime driving, on a Level 1 license that has been held for at least three continuous months must be completed before a student can be accepted into Segment 2. Supervised driving is defined as driving with a license parent, guardian or parent designee age 21 or older.
- Fees due by first class date. No refunds after first day of class.
