Requirements:

- Need to have completed Segment 1 which includes 24 hours of classroom education and 6 hours of driving lesson on the road. This should be completed at least 90 days before first class on a level I license.
- Segment 2 is made up of 6 hours of classroom work.
- Student should bring a copy of record of completion of segment 1 to first class (last level I).
- A \$20 fee is charged if a student does not show up for a scheduled driving session, makeup class, or duplicated certificates.
- Books are sold to students for \$6 (optional).
- A minimum of 30 hours of supervised driving, including two hours of nighttime driving, on a Level 1 license that has been held for at least three continuous months must be completed before a student can be accepted into Segment 2. Supervised driving is defined as driving with a license parent, guardian or parent designee age 21 or older.
- Student must receive a score of 70% or higher on final grade to pass. Up to two retakes in total allowed.
- No refunds given after the first class.
- Classes will be held at 1707 Plymouth Rd., unless a different location is posted. Absences permitted based on instructor scheduling and knowledge of absence.

NOTICE - This driver education provider is required to be certified by the Secretary of State. If you have any complaint that cannot be settled with the provider, please complete the Driver Education Complaint form found under "Driver Programs Division" on the Department of State website; www.michigan.gov/sos. Completing driver education instruction does not guarantee a driver license.

Ann Arbor Driving School, Inc. will conduct the behind-the-wheel instruction in a dual-controlled automobile that is fully insured to cover each student enrolled in the program. At least two students will be in the driver education vehicle whenever behind-the-wheel instruction is provided. The driving record of each individual instructor is available for review upon request.
